We're proud of her, also because she is an ex student in our school.

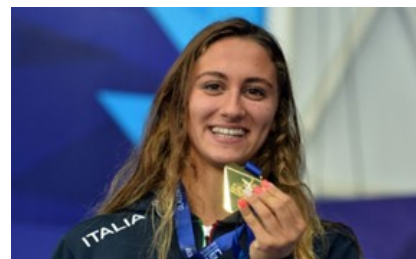

Simona was born in Rome on 18th December 1998. She lives in our suburb in Ottavia, in the north-west of Rome and she attended our school from 2004 to 2012. At the age of 8 she joined the agonistic swimming team. She is the first Italian swimmer to have won a golden medal in

800m at the Olympic games for young people at Nanjing in China in 2014.

Simona is specialised in free style, she won a golden medal in 1500m in the World Young Championship in Singapore. But the best results were in 2018 when she won 3 golden medals in 400m, 800m and 1500m in Glasgow for the European Championship.

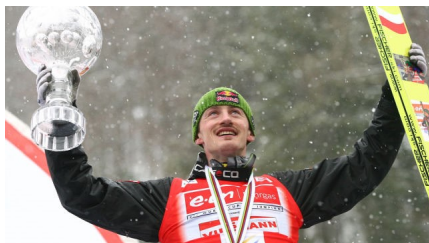

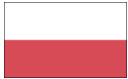
One day, on the Day of the Dead, Miguel took a surprising

Hello readers!

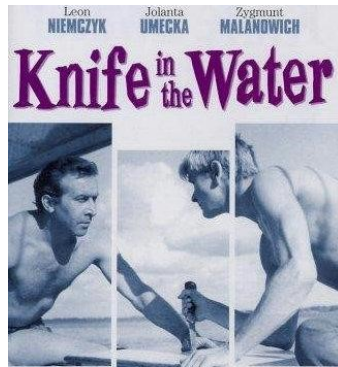



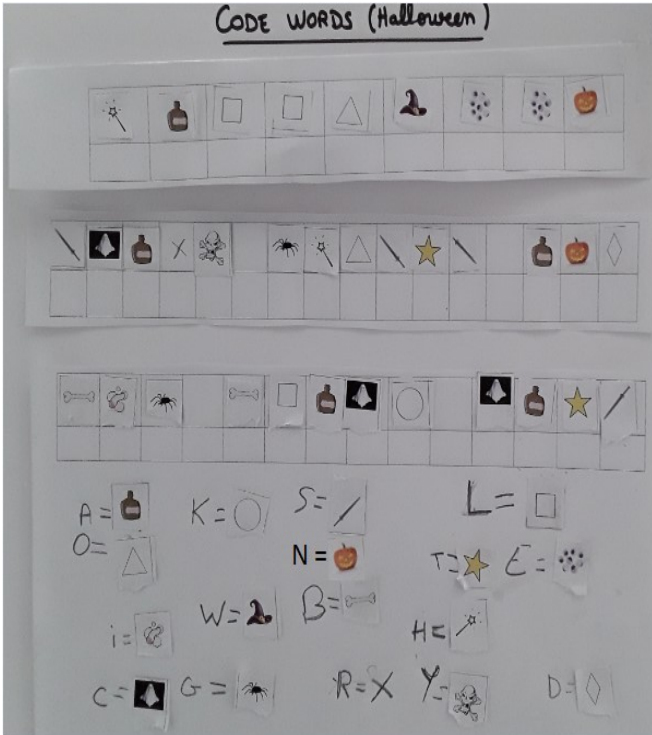
